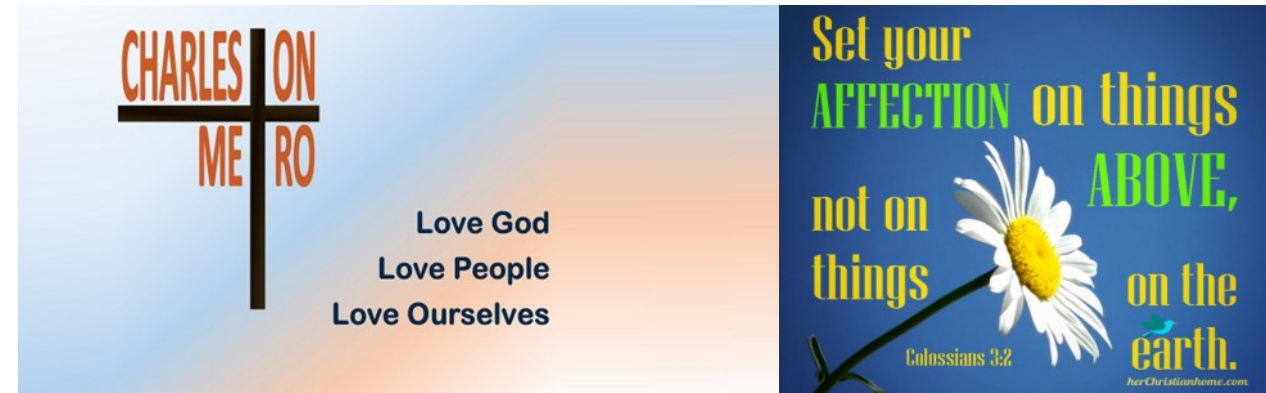

Dear Homeowner,

We will begin accepting new applications on Monday, July 1, 2024

You are receiving this email because you requested to be notified when the SC Safe Home Mitigation Grant Program reopened.

SC Safe Home provides matching and non-matching grant funds to help coastal property owners retrofit their homes to make them less vulnerable to the strong winds that accompany hurricanes and severe storms. The primary source for these grant funds comes from all property insurers doing business in South Carolina.

Beginning Monday morning, July 1, 2024, at 8:30 am, you can log on to the SC Safe Home Application Portal and complete your application.

Grant award amounts are based on the total annual adjusted gross household income of the applicant, adjusted for family size relative to the county area median income or the state median family income, whichever is higher. These statewide and countywide incomes are published annually by the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

If the cost of the mitigation project exceeds the amount of the grant award, the remaining cost is applicant's responsibility.

The following table outlines the three Mitigation Grant Types and their corresponding maximum award amounts

Sustainable Mitigation Award Roof retrofits meeting SC Safe Home Retrofit Guidelines only <i>OR</i> Window Replacement and Opening Protection Retrofits meeting SC Safe Home Opening Protection Guidelines	Non-matching Grants: \$5,000.00 Matching Grants: \$4,000.00
Hurricane Shuttering and Protective Barrier Systems Award Installation of hurricane shuttering and protective barrier systems meeting SC Safe Home Opening Protection Guidelines	Non-matching and Matching: \$3,000.00
